## **CLEANING & MAINTENANCE – INSTRUCTIONS**

## **Cleaning & maintenance instructions**

- 1. Clean with a soft towel and medium warm water.
- 2. Dry the surface if necessary, no moisture should remain on the surface.
- 3. Stains must be removed immediately.
- 4. For stubborn stains, use an appropriate biological solvent. Rinse with warm water and dry using kitchen paper.
- 5. Never use abrasive products (scouring powder, steel wool, black soap) or bleach, wax products for furniture, cleaning products with strong bases, strong acids or salts (antilimestone, hydrochloric acid, unblocking products, cleaner for silverware, etc).
- 6. Immediately wipe up spilled liquids.
- 7. Immediately remove glue stains.
- 8. Traces of wear are more visible on dark surfaces (micro-scratches). These traces are mere visually and do not affect the quality of the surface. This characteristic must be observed depending on the end use of the product.
- 9. Glossy surfaces are more susceptible to scratches because their structure is smooth and even. This traces are purely visual and do not affect the quality of the surface. This characteristic must be observed be taken according to the end use of the product.

## Do you no longer use the (parts of) product and do you want to remove it? Then think about the environment.

- 1. We try to ensure that you have as little waste as possible from the packaging. Do you make sure the waste will be separated?
- 2. Collect empty batteries and hand them in at a collection point.
- 3. Please check whether the product can be recycled.
- 4. Go to the recycling center to take away products.
